



Code of Conduct – Student

Scope

This code applies to all students enrolled at Bishop Tyrrell Anglican College when representing the College and/or wearing College uniform.

Purpose

The College seeks to provide all students with a safe and supportive environment in which to develop socially, emotionally, academically, spiritually and physically.

Aim

The aim of this code is to ensure that the College is a safe and pleasant place in which learning takes place and that the property and reputation of the College is protected. All students are to embrace the philosophy of the College to Learn, Lead and Serve.

Rights and Responsibilities

The **College Principal** and staff have the right and responsibility to

- implement the Code of Conduct fairly, consistently and reasonably.

Teachers have a right to:

- expect the co-operation of students;
- expect that they will be able to teach in an orderly and co-operative environment;
- be treated with respect; and
- be listened to

Teachers have a responsibility to:

- treat students fairly and consistently;
- provide an appropriate range of learning strategies;
- undertake a pastoral role;
- develop in students an awareness and understanding of college rules;
- follow the agreed policies and procedures of the college; and
- communicate with parents and guardians on matters relating to the educational development and behaviour of their children.

Students have a right to:

- feel safe within the college;
- learn in a challenging environment to the best of their ability;
- be treated with respect by other students and teachers; and
- be listened to.

Students have a responsibility to:

- wear the approved uniform well;
- act and work co-operatively with other students and teachers,
- respect the learning needs of other students,
- take responsibility for their own learning,
- be tolerant of differences,
- be punctual and regular in attendance,

- uphold the reputation of the college by observing an appropriate standard of behaviour in transit to and from the college and when wearing college uniform.
- accept the authority of all staff members and observe college rules,
- behave in a manner to ensure the health and safety of themselves and/or others;
- behave with courtesy and consideration for others.
- refrain from all forms of bullying and harassment.
- respect their own and college property as well as the property of staff and other students.
- never possess prohibited items or substances as specified by the college.

Parents/Guardians have a right to:

- expect that their children can interact and learn in a secure environment,
- be informed of matters regarding their children,
- be involved in developing strategies for their own child's behaviour

Parents/Guardians have a responsibility to:

- encourage children to observe college rules,
- work co-operatively with the college to solve problems,
- provide support for teachers in implementing the code of conduct,
- communicate relevant information and concerns to the college.
