- Preparing routines and costuming for end of year Concert
- Maintain ongoing communication between parents and the school in all matters pertaining to Dance Academy
- Prepare timetable and enrolment form
- Oversee the administration of Dance Academy enrolments
- Work collaboratively with the Dance Academy team to prepare and run the end of year Concert
