The Community Freezer originated from a desire to show God's love, in a practical way, to our school community. Its aim is to provide meals to families who find themselves in challenging times.

Purpose of the Freezer

Many families in our school are part of Church communities, yet not all have effective support networks or local family help. Unofficially (although by no means obligated) Class Parents have been coordinating meals for families in times of need. This may be for the celebration of a new child or dealing with illness etc. The Community Freezer supplements and supports this role.

We need your help!

We aim to keep a stock of freezer meals and non-perishable items. If you are able to supply a meal, or other items, it would be greatly appreciated. Just one meal a term or even one meal a year would be invaluable.

Operation of the Freezer

When donating a meal, please place in a take-away container and give to the School Office staff. Include a completed ingredients form (found at the School Office or on the School Website at [covenant.nsw.edu.au/letters](http://covenant.nsw.edu.au/letters)).

If you, or someone you know, requires a meal please contact your Class/Year group parent, a Freezer Coordinator or the School Office. Together we can work out what is required and the best way to distribute a meal/s.

Grocery vouchers, non-perishable items for lunch boxes or money to purchase food items are also most welcome.

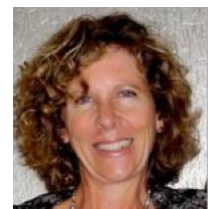
