### Year 7 - Elective Sport Term 4, 2019

Sport selections for Term 4 will be completed online by the students. This is the same system that was used for previous terms this year. Students will receive a link via email to access and enter their sport choices. **Please note that there may be financial implications from the choices your children make so please consult with them prior to them making the choice.** Charges for paid sports will be added to your Term 4 school fees.

Selections are due by **Wednesday 18 September** (Term 3, Week 8).

The choices are as follows with more information included below:

Options	Cost (will be added to Term 4 school fees)
<b>School Sport</b>	Free
<b>Cricket</b>	Free
<b>Beach Activities</b>	\$60
<b>Flippa Ball</b>	\$100

Students will give us their top three preferences and whilst we will endeavour to accommodate each student's first preference, there are limited places for some sports or a Sport option may be cancelled due to lack of interest.

Sport begins in Week 1 of Term 4, **Thursday 17 October**.

- **School Sport:** This takes place on the school grounds and will include a variety of sports.
- **Cricket:** This takes place on the school grounds and will include skills and games. It may be a mix of indoor and outdoor cricket.
- **Beach Activities:** Students are transported to the beach for a variety of activities, which may include sports such as beach cricket, soccer, frisbee or a coastal walk.
- **Flippa Ball:** Students are transported to Terrey Hills Swim School where they will participate in a modified game of Water Polo.

**We would also like to draw your attention to the following school policies with regard to Sport participation:**

- Requests to change sports will only be accepted up until the **end of Week 1, Term 4**, and must come via a completed Sport Change Form. This form requires a parent's signature and will not be accepted if it has not been signed. Students must place the form in the Sports Note Box outside the PE office, for consideration.
- Students may only be dismissed from sporting venues on a term basis and must bring a signed note to the Sports Coordinator **before the end of recess on or before the day of Sport**.
- Students unable to participate in Sport are required to bring a note to the Sports Coordinator **before the end of recess on or before the day of Sport**.
- As Sport is a compulsory component of the curriculum, students are required to go to their sporting venues even if they have permission not to participate in the sport.
- Due to limited staffing numbers and our Duty of Care Policy, we will not be granting permission for students to work in the library or any other school venue instead of going to the sporting venue.
- Requests to leave school at lunchtime will not be granted, unless the parent comes to collect the student, signing the student out from school.
- Students leaving due to sickness, without a note, are to sign out with a parent via the Sick Bay.
- Students leaving due to sickness, who have a note, are also to sign out via the Sick Bay.
- Correct PE uniform must be worn at all times unless other requirements are specifically requested.
