Dance Eisteddfods and Dance Night 2019 - Updated Information

Preparations and rehearsals are well under way for our Dance Eisteddfod troupes and Curriculum classes involved in Dance Night 2019. Please find below a list of the dates and times for the various performances we are involved in. If you are interested in being a parent helper (and did not indicate in the last letter sent home) which will involve assisting Mrs Dolman and Mrs Jacobs with backstage preparations such as hair/make-up, costume changes and student supervision, please indicate your interest in the form below.

Below you will find all current details of performance dates, venues and the sections/times we have been given. Please arrive one hour prior to the start of their section/performance as the students will need time to change, warm up and make any final adjustments to their hair and make-up.

Attire:

All students are required to arrive in their dance tights and leotard/or underneath layer of costume with their Covenant sport uniform worn over the top. They will change into their complete dance costumes and dance shoes at the venue. Costumes will be allocated to students in the week prior to performances. Please note the additional costume requirements relevant to each troupe below and have them prepared prior to dance events:

- **Mrs Dolman's Yr 3/4 Lyrical Group** will need to wear black jazz shoes, beige shimmer tights and neutral coloured underwear under their costume. The 'Artisans' need to supply their own black bike pants.
- **Mrs Jacob's Yr 5/6 Jazz Group** will need to wear black jazz shoes, beige shimmer tights and a skin coloured body stocking with neutral underwear under their costume.
- **Mrs Jacob's Yr 5/6 Lyrical Group** will need to wear foot thongs/bare feet and a skin coloured body stocking with neutral underwear under their costume.
- **Mrs Dolman's Yr 7/8 Musical Group** will need to wear black jazz shoes, black tights (provided by school) and a skin coloured body stocking with neutral underwear under their costume.
- **Mrs Dolman's Yr 9-11 Musical Group** will need to wear black jazz shoes, beige shimmer tights and a skin coloured body stocking with neutral underwear under their costume.
- **Mrs Dolman's 7-11 Lyrical Group** will need to wear foot thongs/bare feet and a skin coloured body stocking with neutral coloured underwear under their costume. A black leotard has also been provided by the school to wear.

Hair and Makeup:

Hair should be worn in a bun at mid-height (Mrs Dolman's groups) or high pony tail (Mrs Jacobs groups), secured in place with a hair net, bobby pins and hairspray. Makeup should be worn, including foundation, pink/brown blush, neutral coloured eye shadow, black eyeliner and mascara and red lipstick. Boys wear their hair in a neat and styled fashion and are to wear some basic foundation, blush and black eyeliner. If dancers are wearing a hat or headpiece, they need to bring extra bobby pins to secure this item in place.

Cost:

Students are generally allowed free admission to the Eisteddfod sections they are performing within but may be required to purchase admission tickets to stay and view other sections at each competition. Parents will be required to pay the general admission fee for each Eisteddfod which is subject to the organising bodies and different venues. Details of these costs are itemised on the Eisteddfod websites.
