

SOCIAL NETWORKING POLICY

It is a condition of enrolment or continued enrolment at Flinders Christian Community College that students adhere to the following boundaries:

Students must demonstrate respect to others and their College

Students must not make any comment on social networking sites (whether the profile or user-generated content is identifiably theirs or belonging to someone else) or any other digital media including email that:

- 1. Targets any Flinders Christian Community College student or Flinders Christian Community College staff member with perceived negative intent, or
- 2. Undermines the name and/or good work of the College.

Harassment, hate speech and inappropriate content should be reported.

Students must respect the privacy of individuals associated with Flinders Christian Community College

Students who create, maintain or use social networking sites must ensure that no comment or content placed on that site by themselves or others:

- 1. Identifies other students or staff as being from Flinders Christian Community College.
- 2. Reveals or publishes conversations that have occurred with Flinders Christian Community College staff.
