The [UCAT](#) (University Clinical Aptitude Test) is required for entry into most medicine and dentistry courses across Australia.

Students who wish to enter such courses will need to sit the UCAT in July-August 2026. Your year 11 students who are interested in medicine have under one year before their test. The best way to prepare for the UCAT is via distributed practice over several months. The Narm Scholarship is offered to both domestic students who are enrolling an undergraduate degree and are experiencing disadvantaged circumstances, and Indigenous students who are enrolling in an undergraduate degree.

Disadvantaged circumstances include living in a low socio-economic area, receiving Commonwealth income support, having a disability or medical condition, or experiencing personal difficulties.

This scholarship provides the following benefits:

- A living allowance of \$6,500 per year for four years paid in half-yearly instalments of \$3250 in April and September
- A one-off relocation allowance of \$3,000 paid shortly after enrolling in their course for students from regional or remote areas of Australia
- An accommodation allowance of up to \$20,000 per year for four years paid directly to the accommodation provider for students from regional and remote areas of Australia who are living at approved University Student Accommodation.

### **Total College Scholarship Program**

The College is extremely fortunate to have a very generous scholarship program. Our benefactors include community and farm industry organisations, employer groups, and alumni. Their greatly appreciated contributions allow up to 60% of our students to receive a scholarship to assist them with their regular College fees.

Scholarships vary in amount from \$1,000 to \$5,000 per student and are allocated by an Independent Scholarship Selection Panel. The main selection criterion is financial need, but other important considerations include likely contribution to community, dedication to studies and intended career path. A single Scholarship Application Form is available which applies to all scholarships generally. A small number of scholarships have specific selection criteria requested by the benefactor which is usually associated with the applicant's chosen field of work. Unless otherwise stated, applications for the above scholarships close at the end of November. Successful applicants are notified in December/January. A covering letter providing information on the financial position of the applicant and their family (including taxable income) is recommended.
