YEAR 7 TO YEAR 12

Green Point Christian College encourages all students to wear its uniform with pride. The College uniform fosters an undertaking to the ethos and values of the College as it demonstrates a commitment to our community. Students wearing the College uniform reflect respect for the College, the staff and themselves.

The responsibility of wearing the uniform properly does not end at the College gates and it is important that the Green Point Christian College uniform is worn correctly when representing the College on excursions and when traveling to and from school.

General Notes

- Hems on all girls' uniforms 7 - 12 should be modest and no shorter than a hand span width from the top of the knee-cap.
- All items of uniform should be clean, neat and have names labelled clearly.
- Boys' formal shirts are to be worn tucked in.
- In Secondary School there is no requirement to wear a hat to and from school, but a GPCC hat (bucket hat or sports cap) must be worn in Secondary PDHPE practical lessons.
- The red wool-blend jumper 7-12 has been replaced with a cotton blend jumper.

All uniform items must be purchased through Alinta Apparel, either onsite or online only, to ensure they meet uniform requirements.

Secondary Uniform Transition Arrangements

At the commencement of 2025, the old uniform will be phased out and the new uniform phased in. There will be a two-year phase out period that will conclude at the end of 2026.

The red and black sports jacket will be phased out by the end of 2026, for all students K-9, and will be replaced with the soft-shell jacket. This garment will provide the outer layer of warmth for both sport and formal uniforms.

SECONDARY SCHOOL UNIFORM

From the commencement of the 2025 school year, there will be a transition period of two years (end of 2026) from the current uniform into the new uniform.

Girls - Summer/Winter

Skirt	Taupe skirt with logo and adjustable waist. Skirt is to be modest in length, no shorter than a hand span width from the top of the kneecap, when standing. (phasing out)
Replaced with	Black skirt with logo and adjustable waist. Skirt is to be modest in length, no shorter than a hand span width from the top of the kneecap, when standing.
Blouse	White short- sleeved blouse with red piping and logo. (phasing out)
Replaced with	White self-stripe short-sleeve blouse with red piping and logo.
Black Pants	Black female cut pants with logo.
Jumper	Red wool blend jumper with embroidered logo (optional). (phasing out)
Replaced with	Red cotton blend jumper with embroidered logo (optional).
Cardigan	Black cardigan with logo has been discontinued.
Jacket	Black soft-shell jacket with logo.
Socks	Short, plain white ankle socks to be worn above the ankle. No stripes or logos.
Stockings	Black opaque stockings (70+ Denier).
Shoes	Polishable black leather lace up shoes with a hard sole and a small heel. Fully enclosed and protecting the foot.
Hair	Hair which is longer than the shirt collar must be tied back. Hair must be of a neat and tidy appearance and should not draw attention in colour, cut or style. Hair accessories should be simple such as hair elastics, bobby pins or ribbons and should be red, black or white in colour.
Bag	Black school bag with logo.

Girls – Sport

Shirt	Red cotton backed polo shirt with white panels and school logo.
Shorts	Unisex black cotton backed mesh shorts with red GPCC logo. (phasing out)
Replaced with	Girls' fit stretch sport shorts 7-12 with red GPCC logo. Shorts should not be tight fitting, no shorter than mid upper-thigh in length. No bike shorts permitted.
Socks	White sport socks – no stripes or logos.
Cap	Choice of GPCC bucket hat or GPCC sports cap.
Shoes	An appropriate lace up sports shoe which provides supported protection and grip for the feet. This does not include canvas shoes, flat sole shoes, skate shoes or basketball boots.
Jacket	Red and black sports jacket with logo. (phasing out)
Replaced with	Black soft-shell jacket with logo
Track Pants	Black microfiber track pants. (phasing out)
Replaced with	Black performance fleece trackpants with logo.

Jewellery and Make-up

Girls in Years 7-12 are limited to one set of either plain gold or plain silver studs or sleepers worn in the ear lobe and a watch. Girls in Years 7-12 who choose to have other visible body piercings need to be able to remove any studs etc during school time or replaced with clear studs.

Girls in Years 7-12 may wear:

- A watch.
- One pair of either gold or silver studs or sleepers in the lobe.
- One fine chain (under blouse – not visible).
- One silver or gold ring.
- Discreet cosmetics (natural skin tones).
- No bracelets or bangles
- False eyelashes are not permitted
- False and / or painted or coated nails (shellac or gel) are not permitted

Boys - Summer

Shirt	White short-sleeved shirt – (no logo) to be worn tucked in. (phasing out)
Replaced with	White self-stripe short- sleeved shirt with logo.
Shorts	Taupe shorts with logo and black leather belt. (phasing out)
Replaced with	Black shorts with logo and black leather belt.
Pants	Taupe pants with logo and black leather belt. (phasing out)
Replaced with	Black pants with logo and black leather belt.
Tie	Boys in Years 7-9 are not required to wear a tie in summer when wearing the formal shorts.
Belt	Dress belt, black leather or leather substitute - no logos.
Jumper	Red wool blend jumper with embroidered logo (optional). (phasing out)
Replaced with	Red cotton blend jumper with embroidered logo. (optional)
Jacket	Red/black microfiber jacket with logo. (phasing out)
Replaced with	Black soft shell College jacket with logo

Boys – Winter alternative

All items for the Secondary 7-9 Boys winter uniform remain the same with the alternatives of wearing black long pants with red logo tie and a long-sleeved white self-stripe shirt with logo, to be worn tucked in with black leather belt.

Socks	Short black socks to be worn with black shorts or long pants.
Shoes	Low profile, polishable black lace up shoes with a hard sole and a small heel. Fully enclosed and protecting the foot.
Hair	Hair that is longer than the shirt collar must be tied back. Hair must be of a neat and tidy appearance and should not draw attention to themselves in colour, cut or style. Rats’ tails, or long plaits are not permitted. Boys must be clean shaven during school terms.
Bag	Black school bag with logo.

Boys – Sport

Shirt	Red cotton backed polo shirt with white panels and school logo.
Shorts	Unisex black cotton backed mesh shorts with red GPCC logo.
Socks	Plain white sport socks – no stripes or logos.
Cap	Choice of GPCC bucket hat or GPCC sports cap.
Shoes	Appropriate lace up sports shoes which provide supported protection and grip for the feet. This does not include canvas shoes, flat sole shoes, skate shoes or basketball boots.
Jacket	Red and black microfiber jacket with logo. (phasing out)
Replaced with	Black soft-shell jacket with logo.
Track Pants	Black microfiber track pants. (phasing out)
Replaced with	Black polyester cotton performance fleece trackpants with logo.

Blouse	White short-sleeved blouse with black piping and logo. (phasing out)
Replaced with	White self-stripe short-sleeved blouse with black piping and logo.
Jumper	Red wool blend jumper with embroidered logo (optional). (phasing out)
Replaced with	Red cotton blend jumper with embroidered logo. (optional)
Cardigan	Black cardigan with logo is discontinued.
Blazer	Black, shaped girl's blazer with logo (optional). (phasing out)
Replaced with	Ladies' wool blend pinstriped blazer - compulsory in Terms 2 and 3.
Socks	Short white ankle socks to be worn above the ankle.
Stockings	Black opaque stockings (70+ Denier).
Shoes	Low profile, polishable black lace up shoes with a hard sole and a small heel. Fully enclosed and protecting the foot.
Hair	Girls in Years 10-12 are allowed to wear their hair out. In PDHPE or practical subjects as required, hair that is touching the collar must be fully tied back. Hair must be of a neat and tidy appearance and should not draw attention to themselves in colour, cut or style. Hair accessories should be simple such as hair elastics, bobby pins or ribbons and should only be red, black or white in colour.

Replaced with	Girls fit stretch sport shorts K-12. Shorts should not be tight fitting, no shorter than mid thigh in length. Bike shorts are not permitted.
Socks	Plain white sport socks – no stripes or logos.
Cap	GPCC bucket hat or GPCC sports cap.
Shoes	Appropriate lace up sports shoes which provide supported protection for the feet. This does not include canvas shoes, flat sole shoes, skate shoes or basketball boots.
Jacket	Red/black microfiber jacket with logo. (phasing out)
Replaced with	Black soft shell jacket with logo.
Track Pants	Black microfiber track pants. (phasing out)
Replaced with	Black polyester cotton performance fleece trackpants with logo.
Hair	In PDHPE or practical subjects as required, hair that is touching the collar must be fully tied back. Replaced with	Black shorts with logo and black leather belt. (optional)
Pants	Taupe pants with logo and black leather belt. (phasing out)
Replaced with	Black pants with logo and black leather belt.
Tie	Compulsory black tie with crest to be worn with shorts and pants.
Belt	Dress belt, black leather or leather substitute - no logos.
Jumper	Red wool blend jumper with embroidered logo (optional). (phasing out)
Replaced with	Red cotton blend jumper with embroidered logo (optional).
Blazer	Black boys' blazer with logo. (phasing out)
Replaced with	Unisex wool blend pinstriped blazer - compulsory in Terms 2 and 3

NOTE:

- Year 12 students have the opportunity to purchase the Year 12 jacket. These are usually distributed at the commencement of Year 12 study, ie Term 4 of Year 11. These can be worn instead of the formal blazer. However, Year 12 students are required to wear the formal blazer for formal occasions (such as for photos and graduation) or as requested for excursions or when representing the College.
- Years 11–12 do not have PE lessons but must keep items to wear if they intend to play sport or take part in athletics events and represent the College.

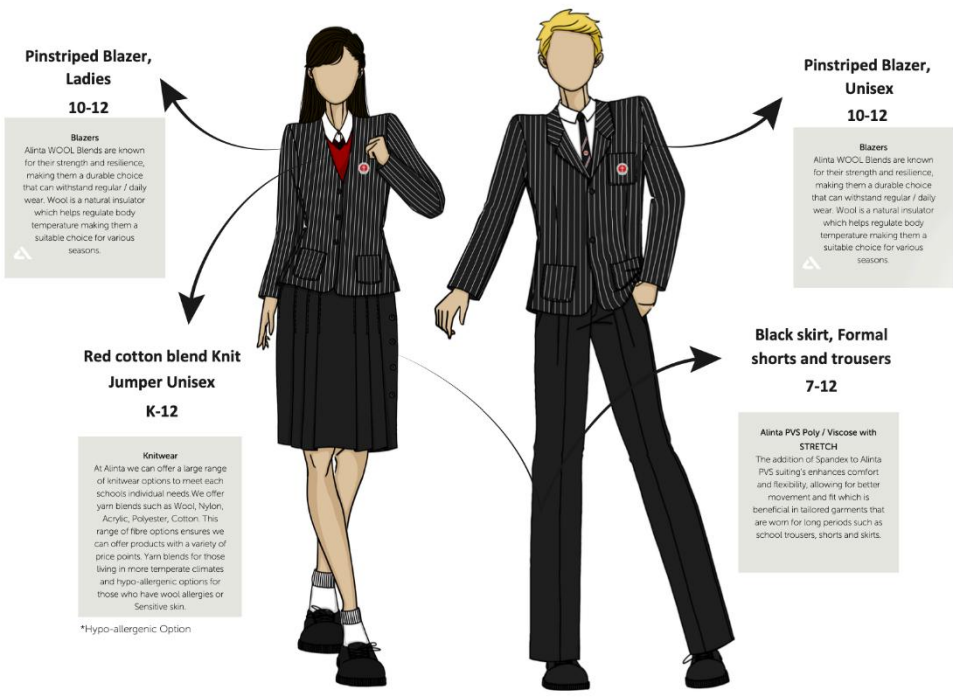
