The purpose of this form is for you to acknowledge that you have read and understood the Code of Conduct (based on the Netball NSW Member Protection Document). By signing this document, you are agreeing to abide by this Code of Conduct.

ADMINISTRATORS:

All individuals, including committee members, team managers and officials involved in the organisation and management of netball related activities are expected to:

- be fair, considerate and honest in all dealings with others.
- be professional in, and accept responsibility for actions language, presentation, manners and punctuality should reflect high standards.
- resolve conflicts fairly and promptly through established procedures.
- maintain strict impartiality.
- be aware of their legal responsibilities.
- develop a positive sport environment by allowing for the special needs of the players (especially children), by emphasising enjoyment and providing appropriate development and competitive experiences.
- ensure activities, equipment and facilities are safe and appropriate to the ability level of participating players.
- involve players in the planning, leadership, evaluation and decision making relating to the activity.
- ensure that everyone (administrators, coaches, players, umpires, parents, spectators) emphasise fair play in netball activities and games.
- where appropriate, distribute a Code of Behaviour sheet to coaches, umpires, players, parents and spectators.
