Code of Conduct Consent: 2021



The purpose of this form is for you to acknowledge that you have read & understood the Green Point Christian College Basketball Club (GPCCBC) Code of Conduct (taken from BNSW Policies & By-Laws).

By signing this document, you are agreeing that you have read & explained this code to your child (U18yrs) & you both agree to uphold the **Mission, Vision & Values of the GPCC** and abide by the following guidelines.

PARENTS/CARERS/SPECTATORS/COACHES/MANAGERS:

- encourage participation, do not force children, remembering involvement in organised sport is for enjoyment.
- focus on efforts & performance rather than the overall outcome of the game/event.
- encourage children to always play according to the rules & support the use of age-appropriate development activities & modified rules.
- applaud good play by all players, remembering that children learn best by example.
- be a model of good sports behaviour for children to emulate.
- teach children that an honest effort is as important as victory, so that the result of each game is accepted without undue disappointment.
- do not use derogatory language based on gender, race, or impairment, or use foul language, sledge or harass players, coaches or officials.
- respect the authority of the referee & coach on court. If you disagree with a decision or behaviour, then, firstly share your concern with your coach &/or Competition Referee Supervisor or escalate to GPCCBC committee.
- recognise & respect the value & importance of volunteer administrators, coaches, scorers & referees who give their time & resources to provide recreational activities for all players; and be courteous in your communications with them, whereby teaching children to do the same.
- do not interfere with the progress &/or conduct of a game.
- encourage player participation at training & respect for their coach's time, knowledge & tuition.
- caring for GPCCBC uniforms, sporting equipment and abiding by on-campus facilities code of conduct.

PLAYERS:

- playing by the rules & knowing the BNSW rules.
- participate in organised sport for your own enjoyment & benefit, not just to please parents.
- participating fairly & safely, ensuring that behaviour is always respectful.
- abiding by decisions, without argument or bad temper.
- approaching any officials (including referees) in a courteous, respectful & polite way.
- cooperating with coaching staff & all other players & opponents on the court.
- displaying a good sporting attitude, with applaud, towards all involved.
- being a responsible team member: on time, encouraging all players, attending training & bringing appropriate equipment to training/games etc.
- refraining from practices that affect sporting performance.
- respecting & acknowledging the contribution of those who create the opportunity for training & games.
- returning the GPCCBC owned uniform at the conclusion of your player's time with the Club (failure to do so may result in loss of bond).
