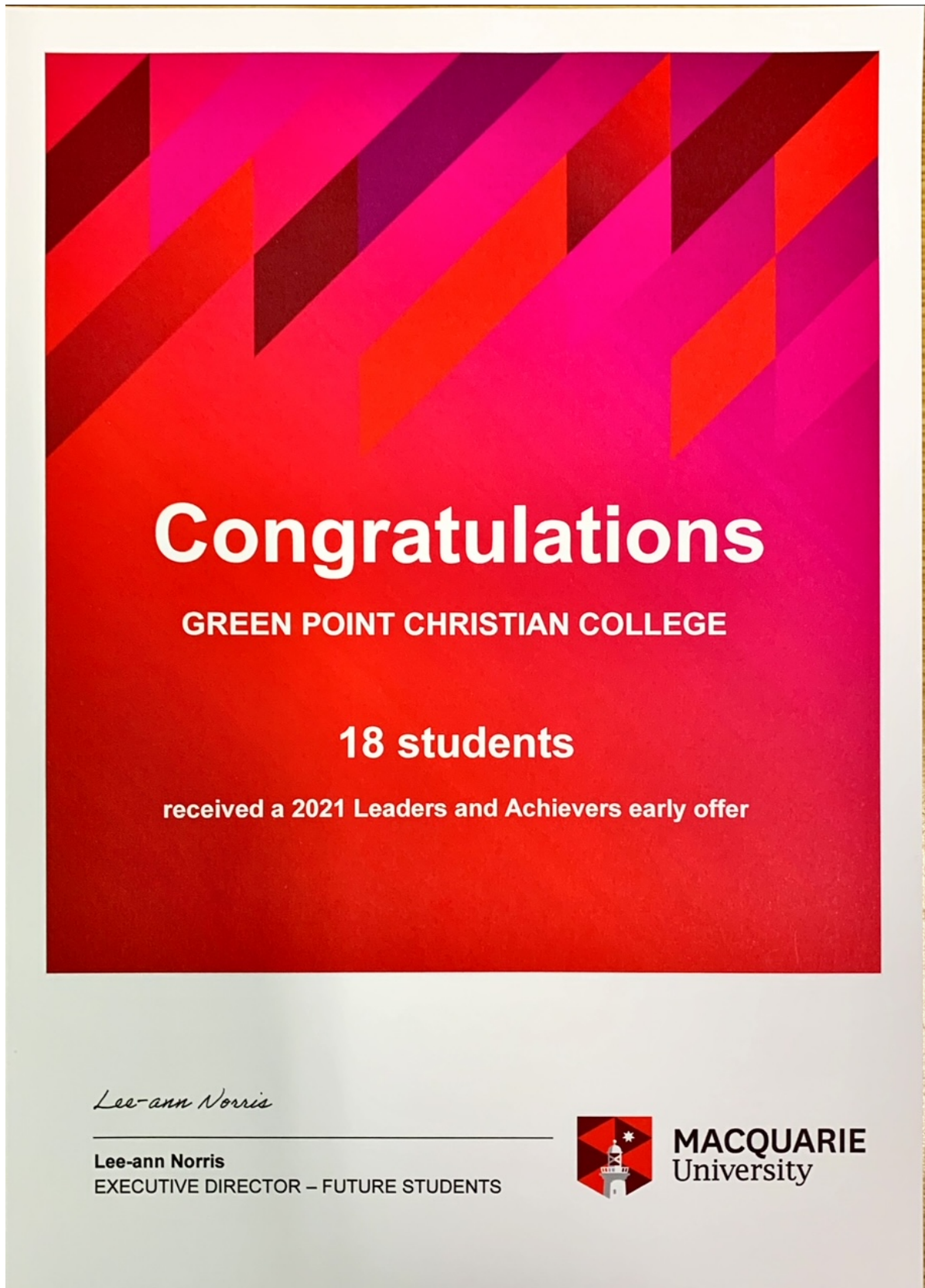
Congratulations to 2020 Year 12
