Schools Recommendation Scheme closing – 16 September

Applications for the Schools Recommendation Scheme (SRS) close at 11.59pm on **Monday 16 September**. Students can access the SRS application once they have submitted their UAC application for admission.

Early bird applications closing – 30 September

Early bird applications close at 11.59pm on **Monday 30 September**, after which UAC's processing charge increases from \$80 to \$215. This deadline is not related to early offers.

Year 12 applicants can also 'commit to pay' using BPAY. Payment must be made, however, in order to have their application assessed and receive an offer.

MACQUARIE LEADERS AND ACHIEVERS

FIRST ROUND OFFERS

Offers were released this week for the Macquarie Leaders and Achievers Early Entry Scheme, round one. Congratulations to all those students who have received an offer in this first round. For students who had submitted their application for round two (which closed last Friday, 30 August), their outcomes will be released on 25 September.

Students who received an offer have been sent communication with the details of how to accept their offer and any other entry schemes they may wish to consider, particularly the Schools Recommendation Scheme as this closes on 16 September. Note, that enrolment at Macquarie is not yet open. We have encouraged offer holders to contact us with any questions and be aware of dates for the remainder of the year, including our Explore Your Options week from 17-21 December.

How to guide students through accepting their offer

To accept your offer to study at Macquarie University, please follow the steps below:

1. To accept your offer, click the 'Accept and Enrol' link that was included in your offer email OR go to this [link](#).
2. Fill in the questions (e.g. 1. Domestic Student) then click 'Get your enrolment information.'
3. Click on Step 1 and use your Macquarie Leaders and Achievers (MLA) application number and date of birth to retrieve your 8-digit Macquarie student ID (your application number is the number you received when you created your application)
4. Activate your Macquarie student ID by clicking 'First Time Login' or by following this [link](#).
5. Login to your [eStudent](#) to officially accept your offer.
6. Within the 'My Application and Offer' tab of your eStudent click 'Respond' then 'Accept' to accept your offer.
7. Confirm your action by selecting 'OK'

If you have successfully accepted your offer your 'Offer Status' will display 'Accepted' or 'Admitted.'

Unsuccessful applicants

Students who were unsuccessful in this offer round have also been notified. This communication includes a video that explains they did not receive an offer because they did not meet one of the following criteria:

- Year 11 requirements are not met
- Activities requirements are not met
- Not eligible for listed preferences

These students can consider applying via Schools Recommendation Scheme if they have not already done so, by 16 September. We also recommend they familiarise themselves with any adjustment factors they could be eligible for and other entry schemes and pathways, including Macquarie College. SCHOOLS RECOMMENDATION SCHEME

Macquarie Uni participates in the Schools Recommendation Scheme, allowing students to have access to more than one early entry offer to Macquarie. This is based on Year 12 students' Year 11 marks and a rating from their school.

What is the ATAR?

The ATAR is a rank, not a mark.

The Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) is a number between 0.00 and 99.95 that indicates a student's position relative to all the students in their age group (ie all 16 to 20 year olds in NSW). So, an ATAR of 80.00 means that you are 20 per cent from the top of your age group (not your Year 12 group). Universities use the ATAR to help them select students for their courses and admission to most tertiary courses is based on your selection rank (your ATAR + any applicable adjustments). Most universities also use other criteria when selecting students (eg a personal statement, a questionnaire, a portfolio of work, an audition, an interview or a test).

How to transfer to a different degree

Many students enrol in a course with a plan to transfer into another course after completing a year's study. A typical example is completing one year of a general degree (such as Arts) and then transferring to a more specialised degree (such as Arts/Law). Other students start a degree only to find it's not quite right for them. They'd like to move to a completely different degree.
