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CODE OF PRESENTATION

The Code of Presentation is a “Door to Door” policy. Students are required to wear the appropriate College uniform correctly from the time of departure from home each morning through until arrival home at the end of the day. Outside of College hours, students should either remain in their full uniform or out of it completely. The Principal reserves the right to exclude students who disregard these requirements.

Rules for Appearance

Hats

The College enforces a 'No hat, no play' policy. Hats are to be worn by all students at all times when outside. No caps are permitted, even on free dress days. Hats should be labelled with student names. It is encouraged to have the family name embroidered on one side of the hat. The College Bucket hat can be worn while playing sport in the Senior School.

Hair

Hair styles of both boys and girls should be neat and tidy in appearance and should not be of an extreme type that will draw unnecessary attention to themselves. No beads, extreme colours, rat's tails, tracks, undercuts, extreme hairstyles (mohawk, buzz cuts {no shorter than gauge 2}, mullets or dreadlocks). Moderation in appearance is required. Students should not use dye or blinding compounds in their hair, except for natural highlights that are natural to the individual students own hair colour. Hair should be cut in such a way that it does not hang over the students face. If doubt exists with a style of hair, a student or parent should check with the Principal before having a style change. Hairstyles must allow the correct wearing of the College hat.

Boys

Pony tails are not permitted for boys and hair must be cut above the collar. Hair should be clean, well-groomed and neat. Boys must be clean shaven at all times.

Girls

Long hair should be tied up if it is shoulder length or longer and no half ponies. No shaved styles. All hair accessories must be in College colours (maroon or navy).

JEWELLERY:

Girls

Girls may wear a single pair of studs (no larger than a matchhead silver or gold round) or sleepers (no larger than a 5 cent piece) on the lower lobe. Jewellery of a religious significance may be allowed but is not to be seen above clothing. Ear cuffs, rings, bracelets or neck chains are not allowed. No other form of body piercing is permitted. No Signet rings.

Examples of the only Earrings that can be worn:



Small plain silver or gold stud silver or gold sleepers

Boys

Boys may wear a wrist watch only. Any other jewellery may be confiscated for a period of time and kept with the Middle Leader - Wellbeing / Assistant Principal - Wellbeing

Jewellery of a religious significance may be allowed but is not to be seen above clothing. Ear cuffs, rings, bracelets or neck chains are not allowed. No form of body piercing is permitted.

MAKE UP:

Make up and nail polish are not permitted.

TATTOOS:

Tattoos are strongly discouraged and should not be visible whilst wearing the College uniform or representing the College.
