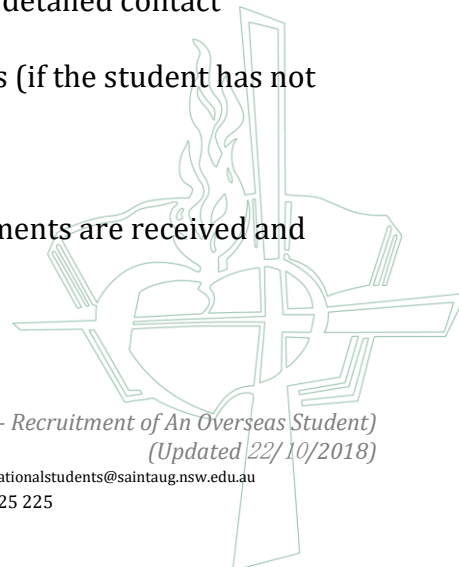

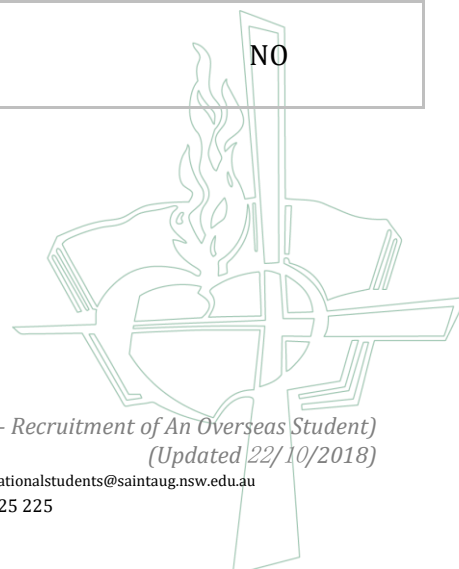

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## Pre – Enrolment Information

### Entry Requirements

Students who are accepted into Years 9 or 10 must achieve an English proficiency level equivalent to an IELTS 5.0, whilst students accepted into Year 11 must achieve a minimum proficiency level equivalent to an IELTS 5.5, prior to commencing studies at the College. If a student has completed an alternative form of internationally recognised English Test, a copy of the exam results must be sent with the enrolment application. If an IELTS, or similar result is not provided, the student will be required to attend a minimum of 20 weeks at one of our preferred English Language Schools prior to commencing at the College.

### Course Content

Year 9 (suggested age: 15 years of age) students will become part of our Middle School cohort. Year 10, 11 & 12 (suggested age: 16-18 years of age) students will become part of our Senior School cohort.

Students cannot enrol into Year 12 (unless transferring directly from another Australian High School) as the senior course is a two-year course, of which the Preliminary Course, Year 11, must be completed in order to progress to Year 12. ### Course Duration

Years 9 & 10 are included within the Junior Secondary School Course (Year7-10) and comprises of 104 weeks in total. Year 11 & 12 are included within the Senior Secondary School Course and comprises of 104 weeks of study.

### Course Credit & Study Modes

As per our Course Credit Policy, St Augustine's College does not offer any Course Credit. International students must attend classes on College campus on a full time basis.

### Tuition Fees

Tuition Fees are reviewed annually, however are correct at the time of the invoice being generated. Fees must be paid in advance in Australian Dollars, as per the invoice issued with the Enrolment Offer Letter. If a student commences part way through a school term, the full term's fees will be charged.

### Study Period

A study period is a continual schedule of study no longer than 30 weeks' duration.

### Refunds

The College [Refund Policy](#) applies to all tuition and non-tuition fees paid to St Augustine's College – Sydney, including any monies paid to an Education Agent and then forwarded to the College. All refund requests must be made by using the *Request for Refund* form and submitting to the International Executive Officer. Requests must be received within 6 weeks of the student departing the College and will be assessed and processed within 28 business days of receipt. **Refund form.** The Enrolment fee is non-refundable. If a student changes their visa status they must continue to pay full fees for the remainder of that course. In the event of a provider default, the student will be offered a refund within 14 days of the default occurring. If the student has not yet commenced the course a full refund can be given, if study has commenced the refund will be calculated on a pro-rata basis. In the event of a student default due to visa refusal, the refund will be calculated using the legislative instrument in place at that time. If the student defaults due to unsatisfactory attendance, course progress, welfare/accommodation arrangements, or other behaviour deemed unacceptable by the College, there will be no refund. ### Deferment, suspension or cancellation of Enrolment

Students wishing to defer, suspend or cancel the commencement of their studies, must apply in writing, outlining the reason for deferment, to the International Executive Officer. All requests will be processed within 10 business days and the applicant will be notified in writing. Students must abide by all College Policies, failure to do so could result in the students' enrolment being deferred, suspended or cancelled by the College and their visa could be affected. St Augustine's College is located on Sydney's Northern Beaches, approx. 20kms north of Sydney's CBD. The College boasts a range of technologies for the students in all areas of the school.
