**NOTE:**

1. Where a family has more than one child at the College in the same calendar year, a second son attracts a 20% discount, a third son a 30% discount and a fourth son 75% on tuition fees only. Please note, that if you had a third or fourth son at the College prior to 2018 then previous arrangements of 50% for a third son and 100% for a fourth son will apply.
2. Tuition and Maintenance fees are allocated evenly across each term's invoice.
3. The Course Fee is billed 50% in Account 1 and 50% in Account 2.

**FEE PAYMENTS:**

An annual invoice will be forwarded in February which must be paid in full or in three instalments. Account 1 is due at the end of February, Account 2 is due at the end of May, and Account 3 is due at the end of August.

**EACH PAYMENT IS DUE AND PAYABLE WITHIN THIRTY DAYS.**

Parent Payment Portal, Bpay, credit card and cheque facilities are available.

Cash will be only be accepted through prior arrangement.

**STUDENT DEPARTURE:**

Parents must provide one term's notice of student departure. If one term's notice is provided, fees are pro-rated to the date of student departure. If one term's notice is not provided parents will be charged a full term's fees.

**DISCOUNT:**

A \$250 discount to tuition fees will apply if the full year's fees (including full payment of the Voluntary Building Fund) are paid prior to 28 February 2019.

**LATE PAYMENT OF FEES:**

A fee of \$100 will apply on accounts not fully cleared by 30 November 2019.

**INSURANCE:**

The College does not insure the belongings of any student. In addition, the College's medical insurance is limited and will only assist with costs associated with significant injuries. Claims are determined entirely at the College's discretion. Parents are required to ensure they have appropriate medical insurance coverage.

**COURSE FEE:**

Covers the cost of resources to run individual subjects, sport, technology and small excursion costs.

**MAINTENANCE LEVY:**

Annual family levy (compulsory) to repair and maintain buildings, furniture, equipment and grounds.
