Notes:

1. Sibling discount

i) If enrolled after 1 January 2018

If a family has more than one son in the College at the same time where all of them started after 1 January 2018, the following fee structure will apply:

- First son - Full fees (no discount)
- Second son - 20% discount on Tuition fee
- Third son - 30% discount on Tuition fee
- Fourth son - 75% discount on Tuition fee

ii) If enrolled before 1 January 2018

If a family has more than one son in the College at the same time where all of them started before 1 January 2018, the following fee structure will apply:

- First son - Full fees (no discount)
- Second son - 20% discount on Tuition fee
- Third son - 50% discount on Tuition fee
- Fourth son - 100% discount on Tuition fee

If the third or fourth son started after 1 January 2018, fees structure in 1 i) above will apply.

2. Payment method

- All school fees must be paid via the College's fee collection system, FACTS. Relevant College's fees invoices can be accessed in FACTS.
- Parents/guardians must initially open (set-up) an account with FACTS. After a FACTS account is opened, a payment plan must be set up to pay the fees.
- Payment plans can be either, weekly, fortnightly, monthly, quarterly payments or one payment in full. You may also request the College Finance office to set up irregular payments.
- In all cases, the College's invoice must be fully paid before end August, each year. Preferably, at least 1/3 of the fees must be paid in each of the first three terms.

3. Discount

- A discount of \$250 will be applied, if the current year's invoice, including the voluntary building fund contribution, is paid in full on or before 28 February of the year.

4. Notice of leaving

- Parents/Guardians must give 13 weeks (91 days) notice in writing to the College Principal or the College Registrar if they decide to remove their son from the College. 13 weeks will be counted from the date the written notice is received by the College.
- If the required 13 weeks' notice is not received by the College, school fees equivalent to 13 weeks will be charged.
